Dismissal is at 1:40 on Friday at the classroom door.



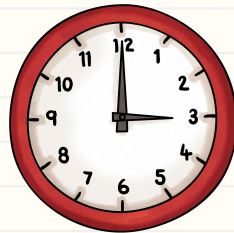
If you arrive after 8:00, please bring your child to the main entrance.
