100 Days of School


Monday, February 14 marked the 100th day of school for the 2021-22 school year. Here are some of the ways our classrooms celebrated this milestone!

Masks Required?	Yes, as of this time, the requirement that everyone wears a mask in all town and school buildings remains in place. The Brookline Department of Public Health has also recommended that the Town's mask mandate remain in place until the week of March 15.
 Vaccination Recommendation	According to the CDC, individuals ages 5 and older are eligible to be vaccinated for COVID-19. Individuals ages 12 and older are also encouraged to receive a booster dose 5 months after completing their primary COVID-19 vaccination series.
Testing Kits	All PSB schools will provide rapid antigen test kits to participating students and staff through the at-home testing program. It is expected that participants test every Tuesday evening.
	Positive Tests • Stay home or vacate from school immediately. • Must self-isolate for a minimum of five (5) days. • Return to school once symptoms improve or subside. • Recommend testing for a negative result after self-isolation. Symptomatic Individuals (Regardless of Vaccination Status)
District Protocols	 Stay home and test or test at school, if symptoms occur during school hours. If positive, follow positive test guidance. Reporting

All positive test results should be reported to the school nurse. Negative test results do not need to be reported unless you are identified as close contact, have been experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, or have previously tested positive for COVID-19.
