

Summer Programs

Our town and school *Summer Partners* are busy planning for a full return to robust in-person summer programming for our children this summer. We will roll out a variety of programs that will serve students prek-12. For more information, please keep an eye out over the upcoming month for an update with program contact emails and phone numbers to be posted on the PSB website!

The planned programs include:

- BEEP Summer Enrichment for our PreK learners
- Project Discovery (serving Grades K-5) Literacy program with small group instruction for students needing additional support and acceleration in reading skills.
- Star Academy (serving Grades K-8) Star Academy is a five-week summer program focusing on the development of academic and social emotional skills in a supportive academic summer camp environment.
- Brookline High School Credit Recovery Program (serving grades 9-12). Four-week program that strives to help students make up course credits lost during the school year.
- Calculus Project (serving grades 7-9). Four-week summer program that strengthens math skills, concepts and knowledge for middle school and incoming 9th graders.
- Extended School Year Programs (serving pk-12). PSB Students in special education who require extended school year services will participate in the ESY program. ESY provides students the opportunity to maintain learned skills and target goals and objectives derived from the current IEP. Services are determined individually for students on a case-by-case basis. *Admission to this program is by invitation only.*
- Steps to Success Summer and Work Connections Program (serving grades 8-12) Providing students in the Steps to Success program with summer enrichment, academic support work skills and internships.
- Brookline Adult and Community Education Smart Summers (serving grades k-5). Providing a wide variety of fun and educational summer programming for children including crafting and cooking classes, physical activities and computer/technology programs.
- Brookline Recreation Program (serving grades PK-10). Summer camps (Camps Coolidge, Chestnut, Washington and Kennedy) for children including recreation camps Camp Viking and Net Results.
