

2022 Metzger Fellows Celebration

On **Wednesday, October 12**, the CDC officially expanded their recommendation for the updated COVID-19 booster (bivalent) to include **individuals between the ages of 5 and 11**.

PSB and Brookline DPH will continue to hold several vaccine clinics for COVID-19 in the oncoming months. The next available appointments are:

- **Monday, October 17** from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Town Hall
- **Wednesday, October 19** from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at Ruffin Ridley School
