HBCU College Fair

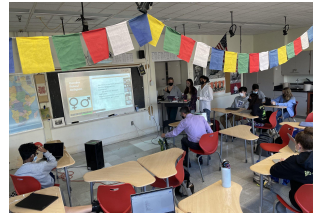
