

Chronic Absenteeism

"We acknowledge that there are often valid reasons for students to be absent, but, to a troubling extent, students are missing more school now than they did previously. Before the pandemic, 13 (statewide data) percent of students were chronically absent, meaning they had missed 10 percent or more of the school year. Last year, 22 percent (statewide data) of students – close to 1 in 4 statewide – were chronically absent."

Congratulations to Heath/Hayes Chorus Kids



On Sunday, December 3, 39 school students, between grades 5-8, from the Heath/Roland Hayes school performed *Lift Every Voice and Sing* on the ice at the Providence Bruins hockey game. The "PBruins" are the farm team for the Boston Bruins in the NHL.

By singing this song at *Hockey is for Everyone* Night, the students represented the Black National Anthem. Heath/Hayes students are the first ever to do this at any AHL/NHL event in the country.

Heath/Hayes 8th Graders' Project

In October this year, Heath/Hayes school 8th graders went to Hillside Pond in Milton, to collect data related to environmental changes. They used sediment cores and tree cores as sources of proxy data to interpret past environmental change. These are the same techniques that climate scientists use to gain an understanding of how our climate is changing. Using proxy data helps scientists build better climate models, make better predictions for the future, and, hopefully, lead to a society that is more sustainable.

Students prepared presentations in which they explained what they did during this project, i.e. what observations they made, what claims they came up with and why those claims make sense.














GOALS


- Grow and produce a weekly harvest of hyper local, nutrient dense, organic leafy greens and herbs to be used in the **school lunch program**.




