### 2020 Updated Regulations for Time on Learning

 Structured learning time is defined in the regulations as "time during which students are engaged in regularly scheduled instruction, learning activities, or learning assessments within the curriculum for study of the 'core subjects' and 'other subjects'.  Regardless of the learning model, the minimum number of minutes for structured time (2020-2021) on learning is 850 for elementary students and 925 for secondary students.

# What counts towards learning time?

#### Included in structured learning time:

- Live in-person instruction
- Live streaming of instruction
- Small group instruction
  - Student independent work while small group instruction is taking place

#### Not included as structured learning time:

- Recess
- Social check-ins
- Non-instructional games
- Unstructured study periods
- Optional programming such as clubs etc.


