

Bullying - Who is Reporting and What are They Reporting?

- Family/Caregiver: 6 Reports Total
 - 4 General
 - o 2 Race/ethnicity
- Administrator/Staff Member: 4 Reports Total
 - o 4 General
- Student: 4 Reports Total
 - o 3 General (2 submitting as reporters, 1 submitting as target)
 - 1 Religion (submitting as target)
 - All student reports coming out of the High School



More Context for "General"

Physical (purposely bumping into someone, emptying their backpack)

Language


- Unkind words ("shut up", "that's stupid", "you're stupid")
- Name-calling ("ugly", "midget", "dirty", "fatso")
- Egregious (telling people to kill themselves, sexually explicit shaming comments)

Technology


 Stealing a student's password and logging into their account, facetiming certain students repeatedly to make them feel excluded/let them know their classmates are hanging out without them, etc

Discrimination - Who is Reporting and What are They Reporting?

- Family/Caregiver: 9 Reports Total
 - o 5 Race
 - 2 anonymous
 - 4 Religion
 - 2 anonymous
 - 1 Not school-based (reporting on incident that did not involve any PSB community members)
- Administrator/Staff Member: 7 Reports Total
 - 2 Race
 - o 2 Religion
 - 1 anonymous
 - o 3 Other
- Of 16 reported incidents of discrimination, 7 were about Day of Race Reform and Solidarity

Technology

Bullying:

- Out of 14 reported incidents, 9 involved technology
 - Forming chat groups across multiple platforms (texting, discord, etc) with the
 explicit purpose of shaming/excluding certain students, texting students to kill
 themselves, making google slideshows targeting certain students, impersonating
 parents, taking pictures of students/recording them without their consent or
 knowledge at school, leaking sexually explicit photos, stealing students' passwords
 and logging into their accounts

Discrimination

- Out of 16 reported incidents, 5 involved technology
 - Out of these 16, 7 were about DoRRs → 9 remaining, 5 of which involved technology
 - Shared documents with hundreds of anti-Semitic, racist, homophobic memes
