






10th Grade MCAS ELA Dashboard



10th Grade MCAS Math Dashboard











Did our Students on IEPs/504s Improve in ELA?








Grades 5 and 8 MCAS Science Dashboard

- We are identifying focus students for each school that fall into our subgroups that are impacted by large achievement gaps.
- These students will be the focus of conversations with building leaders, curriculum coordinators, METCO and Steps to Success
- We are working to strengthen our Tier 1 instruction to accelerate student growth
- In collaboration we will design scaffold and supports to increase the likelihood of success

What Are We Doing As Next Steps?

The school health team is excited to be back at school welcoming new and returning families. Updated health protocols were shared in our back to school letter and are available on our <u>PSB</u> Health Services Website.

PSB health services continues to have a strong partnership with the Brookline Department of Public Health. We have collaborated on current Health and Covid protocols, which include isolation for 5 days if testing positive for Covid-19; and adhering to the mitigation strategies of staying home when ill, good handwashing, testing when symptomatic, utilizing our air filters and staying up to date on flu and Covid vaccines.

Clinics

The Health Department is offering several flu clinics, at which our PSB nurses will provide support as needed. The clinics are available to Brookline residents, students and staff. Registration is required.



COVID-19 vaccine clinics will be offered when the new vaccine becomes available.



- Please join us on September 27th from 7:00 to 8:15 p.m at BHS to learn more about the results of the 2023 Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS).
- The YRBS was administered in May to Brookline students in grades 6 to 12 and measures:
 - Emotional health and well-being
 - Nutrition and physical activity
 - Technology use
 - Use of nicotine, alcohol, and other drug use
 - Behaviors related to sexual activity and healthy decision-making
 - Behaviors related to intentional injury
 - O Behaviors that contribute to unintentional injuries
