I respectfully submit for the Board's review and approval, a request to award and execute Contract No. PW/21-13 "Cypress Street at Tappan Street and Cypress Street at Davis Avenue Signal Improvements" with Massbay Electric Corp., 125 Orleans Street, East Boston, MA, 02128, in the amount of \$102,000.00.

On Thursday, April 8, 2021, proposals for "Cypress Street at Tappan Street and Cypress Street at Davis Avenue Signal Improvements" Contract Number PW/21-13, were publicly opened and read aloud. Four (4) bids were received, summarized below in ascending order of the estimated total contract price bid:

Project improvements include changing the pedestrian phasing at Cypress Street and Davis Avenue to an exclusive pedestrian phase where all vehicles will be stopped when pedestrians are given a walk signal. The Cypress Street at Tappan Street pedestrian phasing will be given a leading pedestrian interval, which will give pedestrians a head start before vehicles are given a green to move concurrently with pedestrians. The pedestrian signal equipment will be upgraded to accessible pedestrian standards with pedestrian countdown displays, in addition, video vehicle detection, and yellow reflective backplates will be installed.



<u>CLAUSE 2</u> - WITNESSETH, That the parties to this agreement, each in consideration of the agreements on the part of the other herein contained, do hereby agree, the Town of Brookline for itself and said Contractor for itself and its successors and assigns, as follows:

The Contractor agrees to furnish all equipment, machinery tools and labor, to furnish and deliver all materials required to be furnished and delivered in and about the improvement and to do and perform all work in Contract No. PW/21-13 TRAFFIC SIGNAL IMPROVEMENTS AT CYPRESS ST AT TAPPAN ST AND CYPRESS ST AT DAVIS AVE in strict conformity with the provisions herein contained and in the Notice to Contractors, Instruction to Bidders, Special Provisions and Additions hereto attached and the "STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS" on file at the office of the Commissioner of Public Works in Brookline and with the plans referred to therein.

The "STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS" herein referred to shall consist of the following documents as modified by the said Instruction to Bidders, including Amendments to Division II (Construction Details), Amendments to Division III (Materials Specifications) and Special Provisions and Supplementary Specifications attached hereto:

- 1. The 1988 edition of STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR HIGHWAYS AND BRIDGES of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Department of Public Works and;


