- Targeted (Tier 2) mental health interventions.

K to 8 educators will have the opportunity to receive training in, **pilot**, and evaluate three separate universal SEL curriculum.

Tier 2

K to 8 clinical staff will have the opportunity to receiving training in, implement, and evaluate a number of manualized group treatments.

- Skillstreaming (Social Skills)
- Social Skills Improvement System -Intervention Guide
- Keeping Your Cool (Anger)
- Creating Opportunities for Personal Empowerment (Emotional Regulation)
- HOPS (Executive Functioning)

 Educators will have the opportunity to come together for weekly meetings to receive training in the curriculum or intervention, plan for implementation, and evaluate the curriculum or intervention based on their experiences.
