- Hybrid
  - Fluid transition from remote to in-school and back
  - Which students will return to buildings

## **Discussed How to Follow DESE Guidelines:**

### ***What will we need to do in order to follow this in Brookline?***

- Staying home if sick
- Face coverings and masks
- Frequent hand washing and hand sanitizing
- Maintaining 6 feet of separation at all times
- Isolation and discharge protocols for students who may become ill during the day
- Smaller, isolated groups of students assigned to one teacher
- Entry screening and other facility operations
- Regular cleaning, sanitizing, disinfecting, and disposal protocols
- Specifically, for this document, we used the following basic assumptions to develop the required supply items and initial recommended ordering quantities
