#### Strategic Plan - FY26 Potential Budget Implications

- > Final year of consultation with New Teacher Center
- > The hiring of a consultant for Vision of a Graduate Work
- Stipends for a team to work on the vision of a graduate work
- > Funds for complete adoption of new literacy curriculum 3-8
- Stipends for Literacy leaders to deliver PD on strong Tier 1 Literacy Strategies
- Stipends for District and School-Based Instructional Leadership Teams
- Contract with Open Architects for data dashboards, including a strategic plan monitoring dashboard

#### Strategic Plan - FY26 Potential Budget Implications

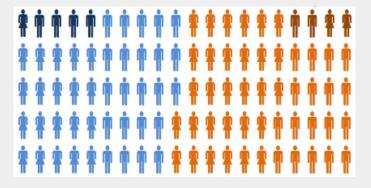
- District website redesign
- > Assess current communication systems, tools, channels
- Fund core SEL curriculum along with related training and support
- Stipends to support workgroups related to creating an inclusive, welcoming environment
- > Fund a robust recruitment and retention program
- Identify personnel record storage solution and migrate documentation
- ➤ Evaluate efficacy of current IT, Data and IS, an Educational Technology service delivery model

#### **SC** Priorities

- ➤ Review <u>FY24/25 SC multi-year priorities</u>
- Consider modifying priorities to align with the FY25/26 Strategic Plan priorities and goals
- Identify process for seeking input from SC as a whole and developing priorities that support and compliment the strategic plan

# **FY25 Budget Update – New Positions**

- ➤ There were 9 positions created and 7 position eliminated since the FY25 budget was approved this spring.
- ➤ Seven (7) are entirely new, one was due to a restructure and one realigned a position associated with a shift in a student's location.
