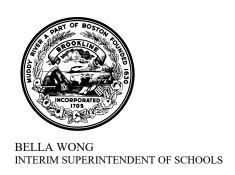

Dear Ms. Palmer:

As per our recent correspondence, I am writing to inform you that an anonymous donor whom I represent plans to recommend a charitable gift of \$80,000 from her Donor Advised Fund to the Public Schools of Brookline Food Services Department to support the Public Schools of Brookline's ("PSB") Zero Waste Initiative. These funds are to be allocated at the discretion of the Food Services Director.

These funds are being awarded with the understanding that this is a pilot effort to dramatically reduce waste within the Public Schools of Brookline. These private funds are time limited and future support is not guaranteed beyond school year 2025-2026 school year.

It is the donor's understanding that through this Initiative, Food Services staff will continue to work collaboratively with the waste reduction staff at the Brookline Department of Public Works on waste reduction initiatives.

The Donor has been pleased with the pilot project and the data presented on the success of these initiatives, and looks forward to continued progress ss on PSB zero waste activities as well as continued development of recommendations by the PSB Climate & Sustainability Task Force.

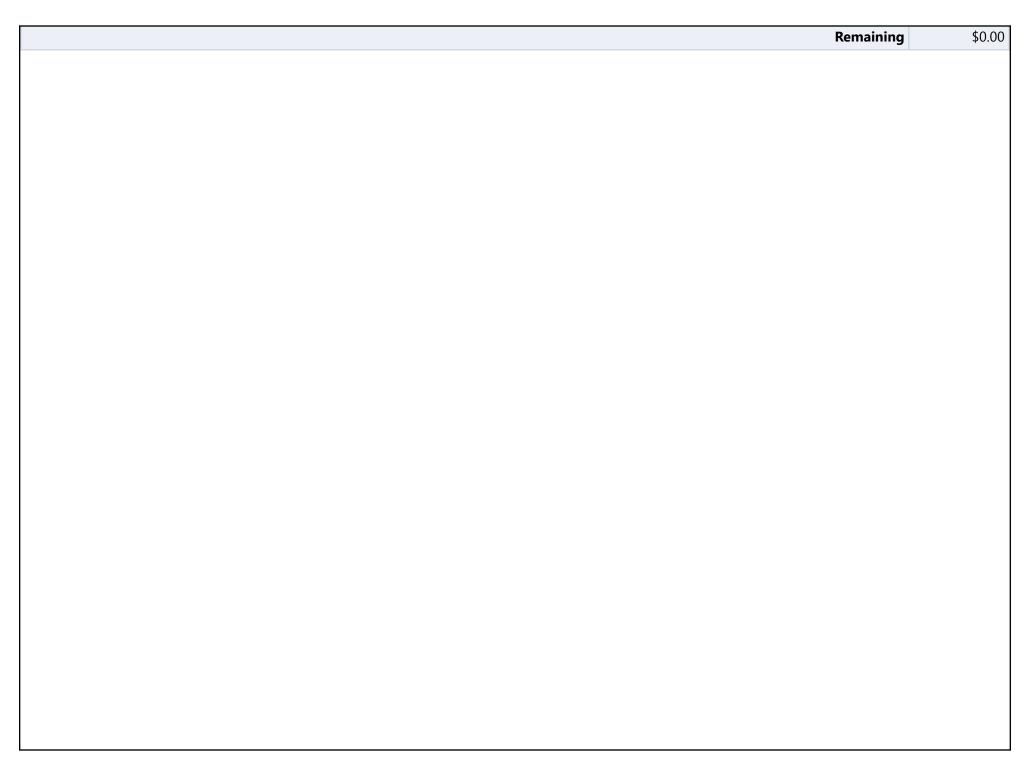

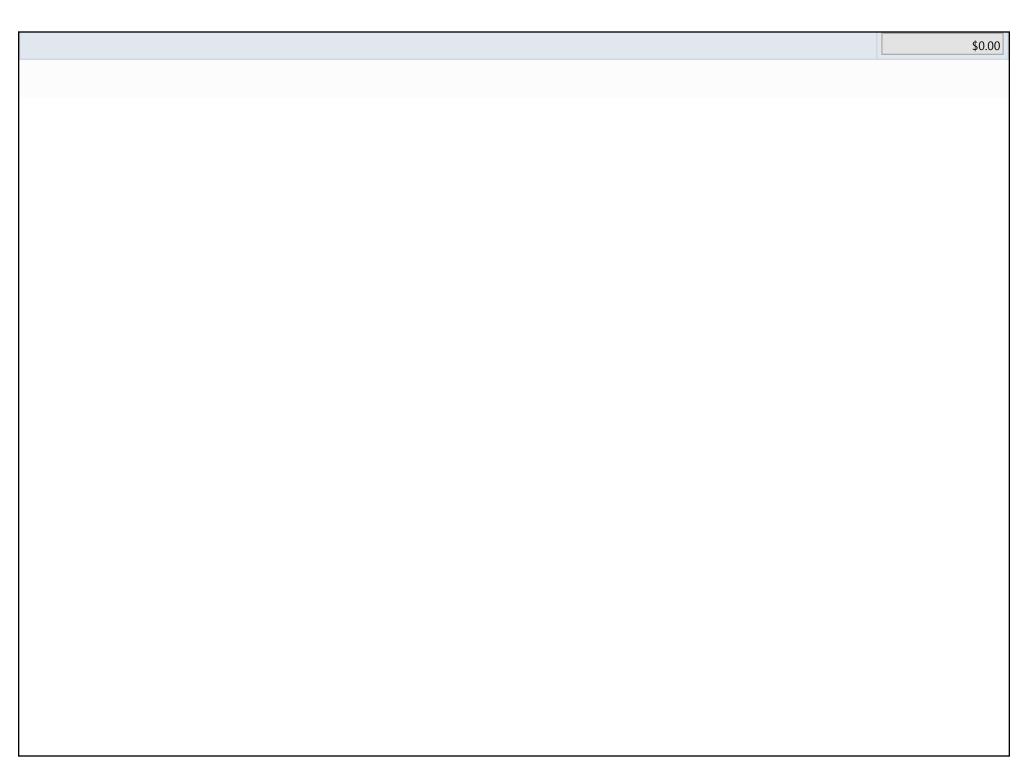

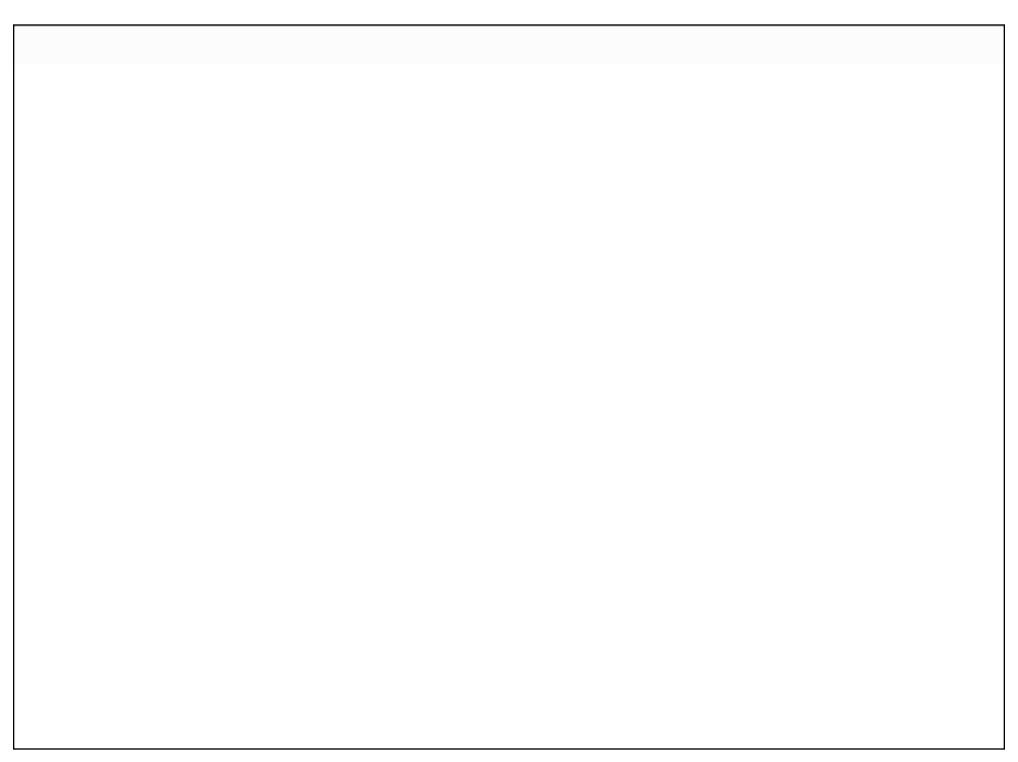
