## **Global Studies Proposal**

Course Description: This multilevel course will be available to students in 10th grade as an alternative to the traditional Modern World History offering in the Social Studies Department. The course presents the story of the modern world through thematic lenses, rather than a chronological approach. Global Studies will offer both Standard seats and Honor seats, as the course, and students, benefit from the perspective of a wide range of students.
