In providing operating grants to organizations, such as Brookline Adult &amp; Community Education (BA&amp;CE), cultural life and the local economy in the community is strengthened.</p> <p><b>Brookline Adult &amp; Community Education</b> will utilize this \$17,000 unrestricted operational grant in the following ways: to update our website (\$5,000); print and mail a mini catalog and/or postcards to increase enrollment (\$9,500); print large banners and posters advertising the program (\$2,000); and finally, to provide staff of six with a meal at a local restaurant as a means to keep morale up and to thank them for hard work and loyalty to the program during uncertain times (\$500).</p> <p><b>Goal 2: Community &amp; Connections</b> Develop and implement a culturally responsive community engagement plan that fosters connections among caregivers, schools, the district and the greater community.</p> <p><b>Goal 3: Climate &amp; Culture</b> Develop a climate and culture in which all students, staff, and caregivers experience a strong sense of belonging and safety.</p>	\$17,000.00	TBD
