

Enrollment Range Forecast Methodology

Creates and enrollment range using prior year forecasts and historical data

Ranges:

- **Low:** FY23 single point projection*
- Mid: Average of three enrollment indicators§
- High: <u>Cropper/McKibben forecasts</u>

Allows PSB to plan for best-guess forecast while also remaining sufficiently staffed to respond to a larger number of students if they come

Please see PSB Enrollment Update April 7, 2022

- * Single Point Projection based on Historical Progression Rates (five-year average)
- Excludes 2020-21 outlier year
- Includes new housing developments to be occupied during the FY23 year as indicated by Town Planning Department (134 Babcock, 21 Crowninshield, Hancock Village
- Assumes BEEP enrollment at 300 students; Assumes SP enrollment at 24 students § Mid incorporates an average regarding:
- immigrant student transfers
- Number of EL students over time
- Number of new immigrant registrations

Conclusions

- Total enrollment is higher than October 2021
- Projections assume bigger BEEP cohort than actual enrollment
- Mobility and churn remain important data points in PSB
 - Fewer students withdrew over the summer period in SY22-23 than SY21-22
 - Fewer kindergarten registrations completed over the summer due to better Winter/Spring outreach
- Positive observations/trends noticed
 - International students are returning at a higher rate than last year
 - Most cohorts are seeing an increase in students compared to prior years
