	Point Person: Kristin Gray The purpose of the PRISM III grant is to purchase, launch, and implement high-		
	quality instructional materials (HQIM) for ELA/Literacy for grades 6-8. This grant will empower educators with hands-on support, high-quality instructional materials, and expert guidance to bring relevant, real-world literacy learning experiences for every student in grades 6-8. The grant will fund 50% of the total cost of HQIM for our ELA 6-8 educators and our 6-8 students. These funds will be needed to fund the remaining half of any curriculum adoption in grades 6-8. It will also stipend a team of educators to serve on the PRISM Curriculum Council to guide our work, provide funding for educators to attend professional development outside contractual hours or substitutes during contractual hours, and provide funding for leadership coaching.		
	The PRISM III grant supports ALL of PSB's core values and GOAL 1 : Teaching and Learning from PSB's Strategic Plan. It will increase achievement for all students by establishing, implementing, and regularly assessing a consistent, high-quality, and challenging curriculum delivered using evidence based practices. It will fulfill the target of selecting and implementing HQIM for ELA in grades 6-8 as well as building a scope and sequence that includes standards-based instruction and common assessments across PSB.
