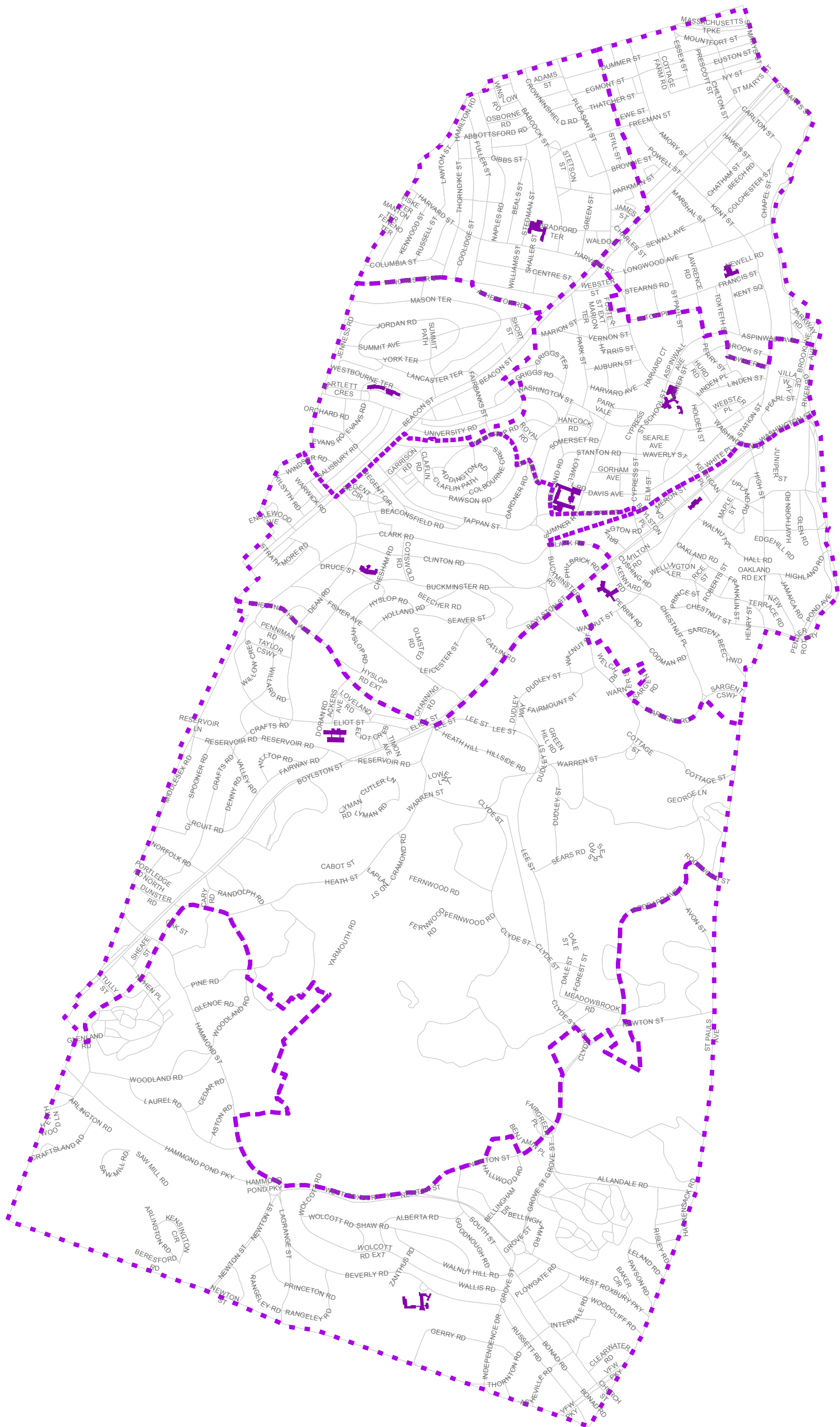
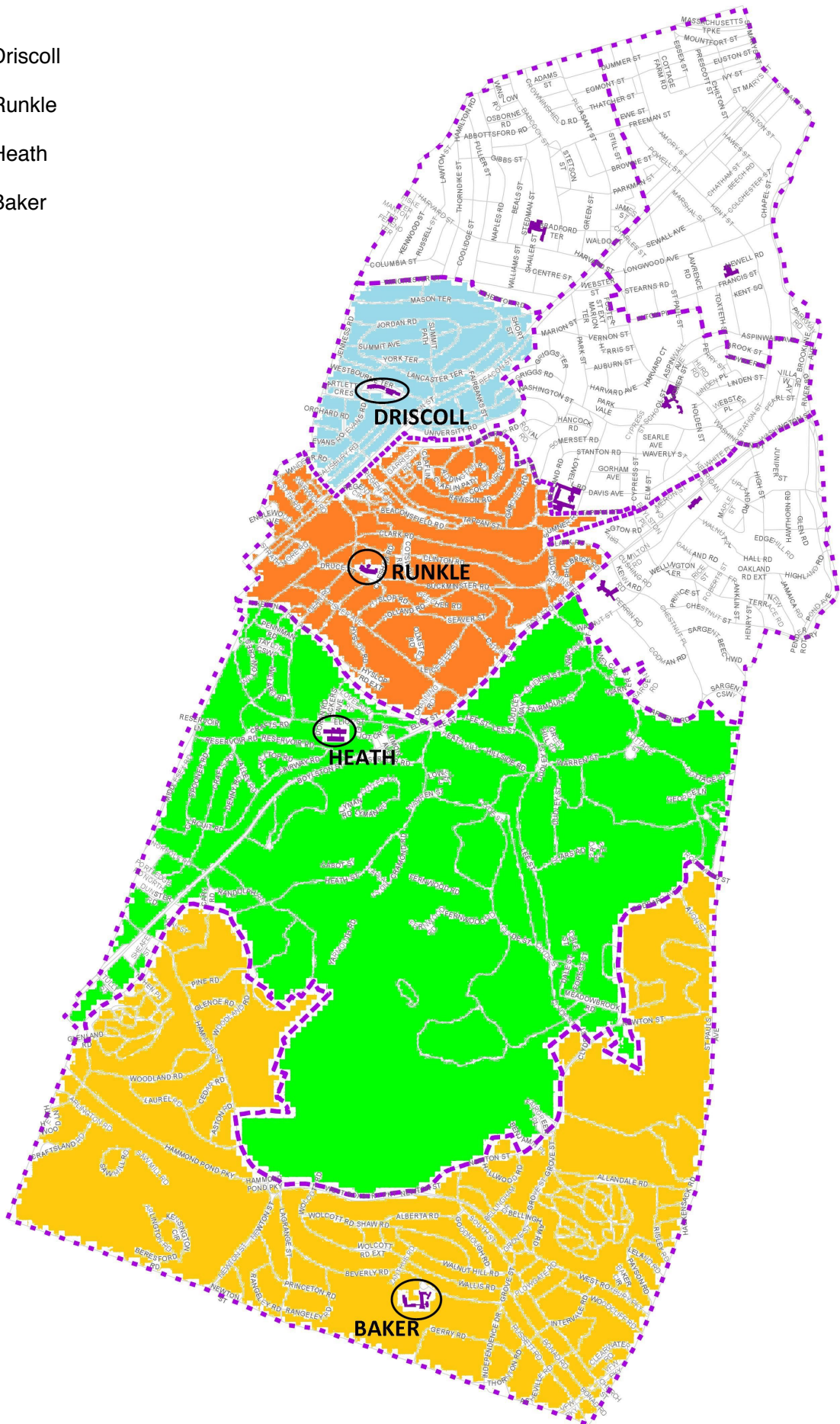

Preliminary Illustration of Possible Fisher Hill School Zone

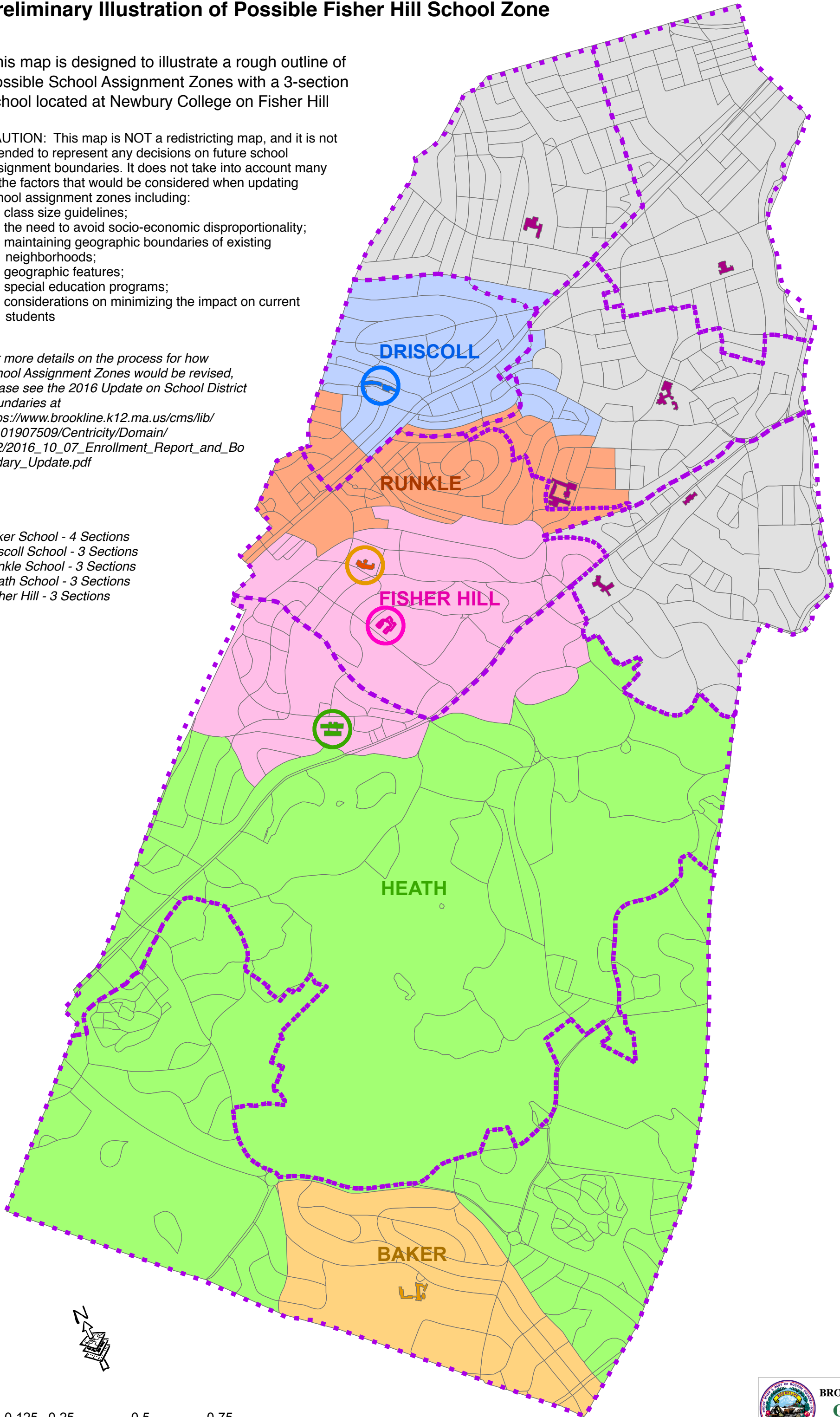
This map is designed to illustrate a rough outline of possible School Assignment Zones with a 3-section school located at Newbury College on Fisher Hill

CAUTION: This map is NOT a redistricting map, and it is not intended to represent any decisions on future school assignment boundaries. It does not take into account many of the factors that would be considered when updating school assignment zones including:

- class size guidelines;
- the need to avoid socio-economic disproportionality;
- maintaining geographic boundaries of existing neighborhoods;
- geographic features;
- special education programs;
- considerations on minimizing the impact on current students

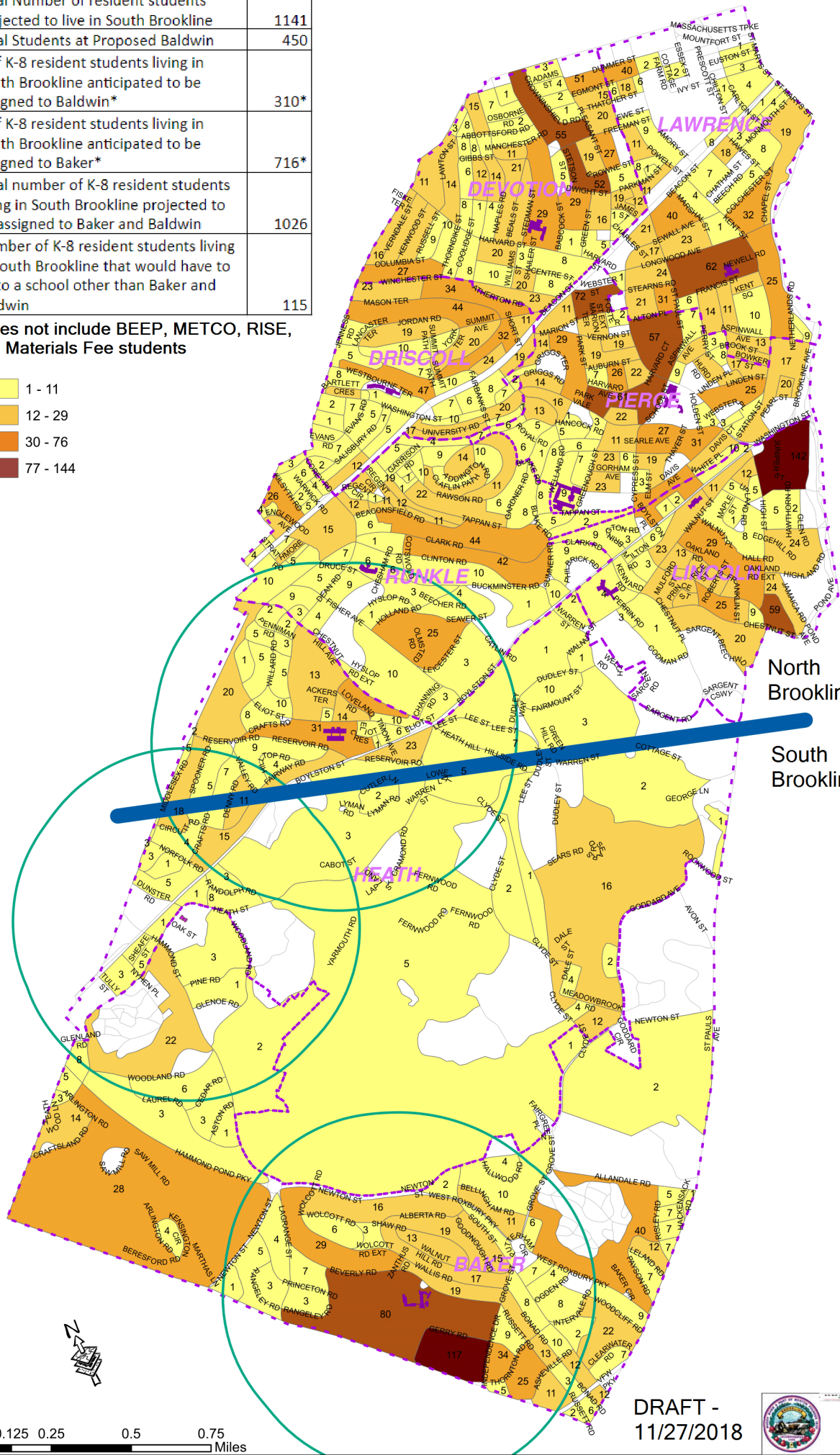
