New Attendance and PED Policies for Students

- **Continuation of Tardy Policy**

- Tardy 1 → Verbal Reminder from Teacher
- Tardy 2 → Second Verbal Reminder from Teacher.
- Tardy 3 → Email/Call Home!
- **Tardy 4 → Student Detention**

- **Left Class/Super-tardy Policies**

- This year, teachers may mark students “supertardy” if they arrive to class more than nine minutes late
- Teachers can also mark students as “LC” if they leave class for ten minutes or more

New Attendance and PED Policies for Students (cont.)

- **Continuation of PED Policy**
 - Violation 1 → Verbal Warning
 - Violation 2 → Teacher may take student's phone to place it in a classroom caddy
 - Violation 3 → Email/Call Home
 - Violation 4 → Email Home + Email to Deans
