

Vote to Accept Gift - Gaga Ball for the Driscoll School

Per Massachusetts General Law Chapter 44, Section 53A, the School Committee should vote to accept gifts. From a practical application, especially gifts that change the structure of school property. Here is an excerpt of the law for your reference.

"An officer or department of any city or town, or of any regional school or other district, may accept grants or gifts of funds from the federal government and from a charitable foundation, a private corporation, or an individual, or from the commonwealth, a county or municipality or an agency thereof, and in the case of any grant or gift given for educational purposes may expend said funds for the purposes of such grant or gift with the approval of the school committee..."

The Gaga Ball pit proposed for Driscoll is hexagon shape to fit into proposed area at Driscoll. We have one at the Heath School in operation for just over a year now. The only anticipated maintenance is replacing the balls from time to time, some cleaning, and resetting of the mats.

Michael Bartlett, Operations Manager for Parks and Open Space, received the below estimate for the gaga pit and pad.

S1,647.96
Total cost
\$4,789.56

Parks and open space can have the estimate addressed to the Driscoll School PTO at the Driscoll School address and go ahead and get this ordered if you would like to move forward. We have a written commitment from the Driscoll PTO to fund this project and the Parks and Open Space team will administer this and oversee the installation after the gift has been accepted.
