Why is there a bus fee for BHS?

- Bus service for HS students in cities or towns is not required by <u>statute</u> or School Committee <u>policy</u>
- In 2018 Multiple Groups and the School Committee supported funding for adding the service with a cost share to families as part of the FY19 Override vote
- 2018 Survey of South Brookline families indicated a need/want for the service and willingness to pay some level of a user fee
- The fee was set at \$400 for FY20/21
- PSB Administration is not requesting a fee increase for FY22



Why did the BHS bus service change from prior years?

- Parents made clear the the need for round trip reliable service
 - Former service was AM only, shuttle bus, first come first serve
 - Concerns about MBTA access, PM only, capacity and reliability
- <u>Survey</u> indicated/supported individual concerns and anecdotal stories for providing consistent round trip BHS bus service in South Brookline



South Brookline Bus Data

- SOBRO Students Reside in Baker, Baker/Heath, Heath, and the Baker/Heath/Runkle/Lincoln Zones
- 496 students in Grades 9 12 for 2019-20
- 141 Students registered for BHS bus service 19-20
- About 30% of the zoned population for 2019-20
- Ridership dropped to 40% of FY20 Levels in FY 21
- 505 students from South Brookline are expected to be in Grades 9-12 at BHS for 2021-22
- 145-155 Anticipated registered riders for 2021-22

South Brookline Bus Data

- Students residing 1.5 miles or more from BHS are eligible for this optional service
- 55 Seats available for HS students on a bus
- Buses can make two runs in AM and PM, so that is 110 reserved seats per bus
- Due to dynamic BHS student schedules, not all students ride every day
- We have flexibility in the PM and Late PM buses for students and expect that to continue with similar registration totals for 2021/22
- We do not overbook trips for paying customers
