With the unanimous approval of the Brookline Planning Board, Zoning Board of Appeals, School Committee, Building Commission, and Select Board, Gilbane (the Construction Manager) is preparing to begin construction of the new Driscoll School Project. The new school will be constructed adjacent to the existing fully operational school. Once complete, the students will move into the new fossil fuel free building, and the existing school will be demolished. A new park and playground for student and community use with appropriate play areas for all grade levels and a synthetic turf play field will be constructed where the existing school now stands. As approved by Brookline's Transportation Board, the new school will have improved pedestrian, bike, and vehicular access from both Westbourne Terrace and Washington Street.

Gilbane will mobilize on site the week of 6/14/21. The approved site logistics plan will begin installation the week of 6/21/21. Details include:

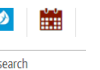
- > Survey crews will install markers to establish building corners and site fence location.
- > Site contractor will begin fence installation the week on 6/21/21.
- > Site contractor will install erosion control measures the week of 6/21/21.
- > Site contractor will plan and organize with team in preparation for tree clearing. Tree clearing to begin the week of 7/8/21.
- > Temporary playgrounds to be installed in July 2021.
- > **Alley by Washington Street:** There will be additional borings taken from the alley adjacent to the site the week of July 8 (2 day duration).

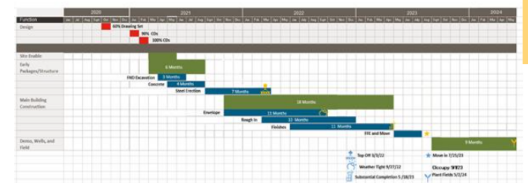
