Drafting a Letter Together about Communication to Caregivers

- SK suggested a discussion before the email goes out with teachers, referenced past practices, so teachers know what happened and know what they can say
- Discussion of when to send the email: waiting for an event to occur OR send it out proactively
- Discussion of what the email should include and what the tone should be: transparency, confidentiality, safety, trust and timeliness

- LH spoke about the difficulties of the job and the shifting demands of the community
- The assumption of good will has declined across town
- MH and SK have offered to draft the communication and share it with School Council
- Need to a focus on the positives, acknowledge what is going well, how passionate the teachers, how hard the administrators are working
- PTO will explore a medium that highlights the positives of the Lawrence community
