Heath School Summer Reading Requirements:

Heath School rising 7th graders will read

one of the following realistic fiction choices:

- The Stars Beneath Our Feet by David Barclay Moore
- *Merci Suarez Changes Gears* by Meg Medina
- *Harbor Me* by Jacqueline Woodson
- New Kid by Jerry Craft

and **two books**, following author Gene Yang's **READING WITHOUT WALLS CHALLENGE**. Here's a <u>podcast with Gene Yang about his challenge</u>.

This challenge prompts students to broaden their understanding of themselves and the world around them through reading:

- #1. Read a book about a **character** who doesn't look like you or live like you.
- #2. Read a book about a **topic** you don't know much about.
- #3. Read a book in a **format** that you don't normally read for fun.

This might be a chapter book, a graphic novel, a book in verse, a picture book, or a hybrid book. Students will find many choices on the Public Schools of Brookline Summer Reading List that will meet these challenge criteria.
