

Materials List for all Health 7th and 8th Graders

Materials List:

- Three to four 1"-1.5" binders
- 18 section dividers
- A package of lined paper
- A package of pencils
- A package of pens
- At least two highlighters
- At least 1 red pencil or pen
- Erasers
- A pencil case with your name on it
- 1 metric Ruler (centimeters + millimeters) that fits into a 3-ring binder
- 3 bound composition notebooks with at least 100 pages - one for ELA, one for Health, and one for Science (bound, not spiral)
- At least 1 durable folder
- 1 spiral notebook (Spanish)
- A scientific calculator:
 - o 7th graders need a Texas Instrument TI-30X IIS or TI-34 scientific calculator or another small, inexpensive scientific calculator with, at least, parentheses and exponent capabilities.
 - o 8th graders are recommended (but not required) to get a Texas Instrument TI - 84 plus or plus silver graphing calculator.
- An assignment book
- Stickers & decorative tape

Here's how your materials will be organized between your classes:

Binders:

- A sturdy pocket folder or shared binder for **ELA**.
- A 1-1.5" three-ring binder for **Math**, with lined paper, a ruler and 10 dividers.
- A 1"-1.5" three-ring binder for **Social Studies**, with lined paper and 5 section dividers.
- A 1" - 1.5" three-ring binder for **Spanish/French and Health**, with lined paper and 3 section dividers.
- Note that you do not need a binder for science. Science materials will be online or stored in a composition notebook (your "Science Lab Notebook")

In your pencil case...

- At least 3 Pencils and 3 Pens.
- Red pencil or pen for Math class.
- Erasers
- Highlighters
- Pencil sharpener

Calculator:

Bring your calculator to Math class every day.

Computers:

- You will be using computers daily. You need to be prepared to transfer files back and forth from school and home, and to back up your files.
- All students have a school-based google drive account for storing and sharing files.

Assignment book:

You are expected to bring this to every class every day so you can record upcoming homework assignments.
