# Here's how your materials will be organized between your classes:

#### Binders:

- A sturdy pocket folder or shared binder for **ELA**.
- A 1-1.5" three-ring binder for **Math**, with lined paper, a ruler and 10 dividers.
- A 1"-1.5" three-ring binder for **Social Studies**, with lined paper and 5 section dividers.
- A 1" 1.5" three-ring binder for **Spanish/French and Health**, with lined paper and 3 section dividers.
