Binders:

- A sturdy pocket folder or shared binder for **ELA and Health**.
- A 1-1.5" three-ring binder for **Math**, with lined paper, a ruler and 10 dividers (Raskin's class only).
- A 1"-1.5" three-ring binder for **Social Studies**, with lined paper and 5 section dividers.
