As a result of listening closely to a wide variety of perspectives, the School Committee and Superintendent Bott have developed a Naming Process that will put Coolidge Corner students and graduates of Devotion School who now attend Brookline High School at the center of the nomination process, allow for adults to provide proper support and guidance to these students, and ensure that all perspectives are heard and valued.

There will be nine Coolidge Corner students and three Brookline High School students who graduated from Devotion School will be on the Nominations Committee. With adult support, these students will review the nominations for the new school name be responsible for selecting up to 10 names to be considered further by the School Committee.

Coolidge Corner students in grades 3-8 and Brookline High School students who graduated from the Devotion School are invited to apply to be leaders on the renaming process for the Coolidge Corner School. Students selected to be on the Nominations Committee will review all nominations for the new school name and decide which 10 names should be recommended to the School Committee.

## What are the characteristics we are looking for in the students on the Nominations Committee?

The Coolidge Corner Naming Process needs students who:

- Work well with others
- Listen well and encourage others to participate
- Like to learn and are curious
- Represent the diverse perspectives and backgrounds of the Coolidge Corner School community
- Recognize when something is wrong and act to make it right
- Demonstrate an interest in social justice issues


## How does a student apply to be on the Nominations Committee?

- Students can apply or they can be nominated by a Coolidge Corner or Brookline High School staff member to join the Nominations Committee
- Students complete the application form and answer three questions in writing or by creating a video.
- Students provide the name of one adult who knows them well and can act as a reference. This adult could be a teacher from any school, a coach, religious leader from your community, music instructor, community organization leader, etc).
- Applications are due on October 10th at 5:00 p.m.
- Applications can be completed online, are available in the Main Office of CCS, or can be downloaded here.


## When will the Nominations Committee meet?

- The Nominations Committee will meet regularly from mid October to mid-December
- It will typically meet on Wednesdays either from 1:40 to 2:30 or after school.
- There may be some night meetings or community forums which will be optional
- When meetings happen during the school day students will be excused from class and we will work with teachers to address any missed work


## Timeline for work students will do on the Nominations Committee

October 10 - Deadline for Submitting Applications to be on the Nominations Committee
October 20 - November 15:
The students on the Nominations Committee will work together with the Coolidge Corner School principal Buller, Vice Principal Ola, and other community members to learn about:

- Working together as a team;
- The history of Coolidge Corner School;
- How and why the Town has decided to change the school name; and
- The history of slavery and the anti-slavery movement in Brookline.

November 15 - December 15:
- The Nominations Committee reviews all nominations, gets input from Coolidge Corner School Community students, families, alumni, and former staff members and decides up to 10 "semi-finalist" names that will be recommended.
- To review the nominations, the students will be supported by Principal Buller, vice principal Ola, members of the Town's Ad Hoc Task Force on School Names and others who will be researching the nominations.


## December 15 - January 15

A few members of the Nominations Committee will work with members of the School Committee and the Ad Hoc Task Force on School Names to lead the process to select a few finalist names that will be recommended to the full School Committee.
