


COVID-19 CASES: DISTRICT DASHBOARD (SY2021-22)



Close contacts are defined as anyone has interacted with a COVID-19 positive individual under the following circumstances: The interaction must be indoors, within six feet of distance, lasted for a combined total of 15 minutes or more over a 24 hour period, and occurred within a 48 hour period before the individual tested positive/displayed symptoms for COVID-19.
