This year the Public Schools of Brookline will be offering *Google Apps for Education* (GAFE) accounts to students.

Google Apps for Education is used by schools and universities worldwide to provide online productivity and collaboration tools to staff and students in a protected, advertisement-free domain. Google Apps for Education is hosted online by Google but managed by the Public Schools of Brookline. Unlike consumer Google accounts, this managed environment allows Brookline to provide appropriate access to tools and settings to help our students grow as digital citizens. Students and staff will be able to use collaborative tools to create documents, presentations, and sites from any Internet connected device at school or home.

Using GAFE accounts, students and staff will have access to the following tools along with collaborative features:

Docs: A word processing tool **Sheets:** A spreadsheet tool **Slides:** A presentation tool

Sites: A tool for building websites and portfolios.

Storage: 30gb of online storage

The students will have a username in an email format (<u>17smithj@psbma.org</u>), however email functionality will be disabled. The username will allow students to collaborate on projects with classmates and share their work with teachers. We anticipate that *Google Apps for Education* will provide Brookline students and staff with essential digital tools in a safe, reliable, and environmentally friendly workspace. Together staff and students will become skillful learners and innovators who use these tools to support and develop skills within the "Four C's:" critical thinking, communication, collaboration, creativity while strengthening their digital citizenship skills including: strategic searching, research skills, digital creation rights, and safe online sharing.
